

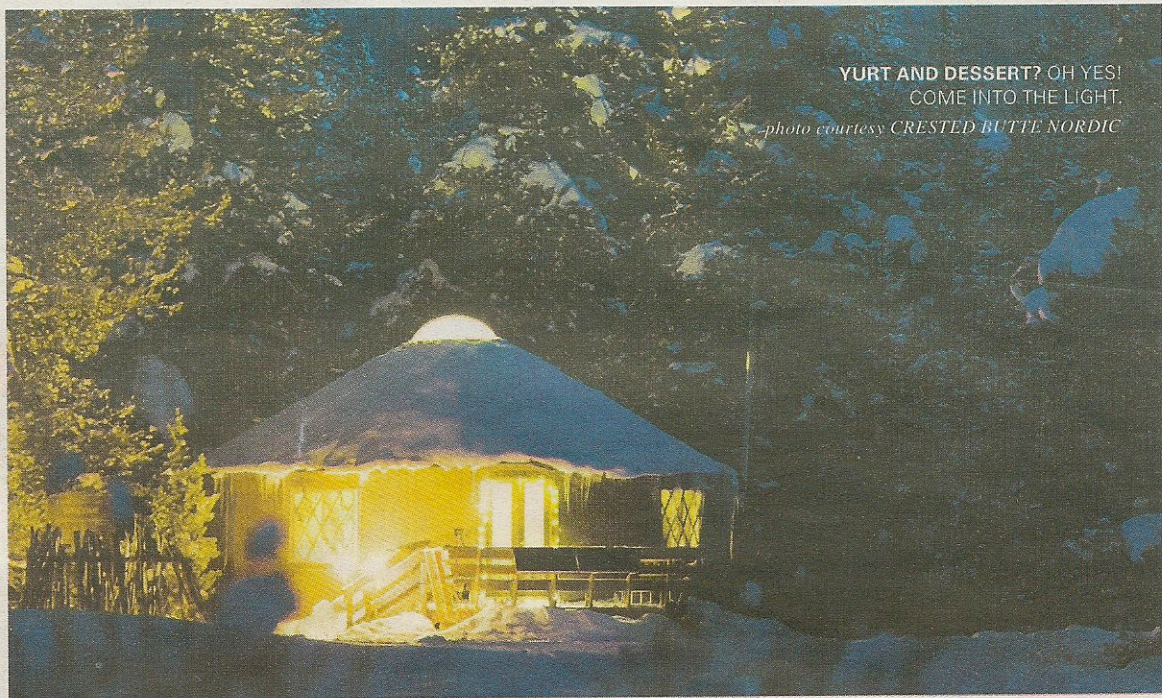
WILD EATS
